The required reading assignments are listed on the back (they are all paperbacks). Remember that the grades for these summer reading tests will be part of your first quarter grades. Your Social Studies and English selections are based on whether you are scheduled for the Honors-level course, for Regents or LA, so ***check your course schedule in May before you begin the readings.*** (For AP European History or AP American History, there is an alternate assignment that will be distributed in class or mailed home during the summer. This is in place of the level 10 and 11 Social Studies books.)

Books: Books (new and used) are available through the SJB online bookstore beginning the last week of June at www.stjohnsdhs.bkstr.com as well as in most commercial bookstores and on line retail. Please do not wait until the last moment to acquire copies. Please see the reverse for all the details. Also, Buy Back Days are June 9th and 10th from 10 to 1:30 in the back lobby.

Notes: It is highly recommended for all selections that students take notes regarding each book so that they can use the notes to review for the tests in September. However, no notes will be collected or included in the grades for any of the summer reading exams.

Assessment: There will be a test for each of the book selections that are listed. These tests will be administered the first week of class in September and will be part of the 1st quarter grades and discussion. All students are to be prepared to take the tests at that time. The tests will be a combination of short answers, essays and multiple choice. (In the case of Religion selections, there will also be a follow-up book project assigned the first quarter.)
